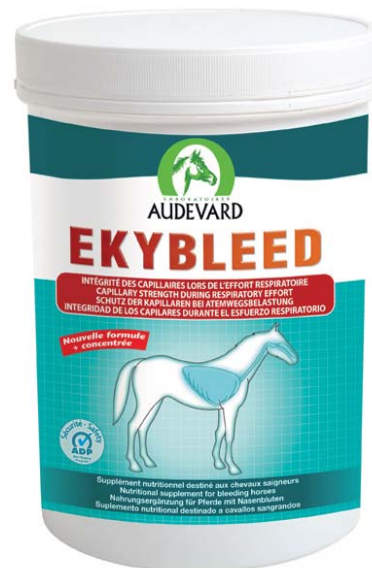
The vegetal extracts found in the EKYBLEED formula have been selected for their recognized beneficial effects on both systems:

Uses

Horses with pulmonary capillary sensitivity.

Red vine leaf: 300g
Vitis vinifera

Orthosiphon: 100g
Orthosiphon aristatus

Horse chestnut: 100g
Aesculus hippocastanum

Sweet clover: 200g
Melilotus officinalis

Dandelion: 100g
Taraxacum officinale

Rosemary: 100g
Rosmarinus officinalis

Directions for use

1 level scoop (35g) per day for two weeks.

EKYBLEED can be administered all year long. Ask your vet for advice.
